Summer 2027 GRADS Program Details:

The GRADS program, designed specifically for campers aged 12-14 who are ready for a more advanced camp experience. This exciting program offers a unique blend of camp, leadership development, and adventures. Campers will start each day as Counselors in Training (CIT), assisting camp counselors with daily routines to build valuable leadership skills. In addition to their CIT responsibilities, participants will embark on 1-2 offsite trips each week, including a special leadership trip every Monday. These leadership trips provide hands-on learning experiences, such as navigating the MTA system with the support of a knowledgeable staff member, ensuring that campers develop both practical skills and confidence.

Registration:

A minimum deposit of \$250 per child must accompany registration. Registration will be made through our on-line registration system called Campsite. After you contact our registrar, you will receive a link to set-up an account. All major credit cards are accepted.

Enrollment:

All non-members of Commonpoint Central Queens pay a \$150 registration fee per family. Families who hold a current CQ membership at the time of enrollment must have their membership active for the entire duration that the child is enrolled in camp. If the membership expires before the camp season begins, membership renewal or payment of the non-member registration fee is required at the time of enrollment. Any changes made to enrollment on or after your child's start date to not qualify for discounted rates.

Payment Plan:

- A payment plan is available upon request, consisting of 5 payments of 20% of the balance on the following dates: March 15th, April 15th, May 17th, May 31st, and June 15th.
- If you register on or after May 1st, there will be 4 payments of 25% of the balance on the following dates: March 15th, May 17th, May 31st, and June 15th.
- Those registering after June 15th, 2027 may not enroll in a payment plan and payment is due in full at time of enrollment
- Payment will be automatically taken from the primary payment method on file on the plan dates unless an email is sent to sascamp@commonpoint.org stating a different method of payment will be provided



Payments and Refunds:

- DEPOSITS ARE REFUNDABLE THROUGH March 15th, 2027.
- Payment of 20% of the balance is required by March 15th, 2027. Full payment of all fees is required by May 1st 2027.
- No child will be permitted to begin camp if there is an outstanding balance.
- If you withdraw between March 15th, 2027 and April 30th, 2027, a refund of tuition will be made minus the deposit and a \$100 cancellation fee per child.
- Between May 1st, 2027 and June 28th, 2027, a refund of tuition will be made minus the deposit and a \$250 cancellation fee per child.
- After camp begins, there will be NO REFUND under any circumstances, even in the case of illness or if the child leaves camp on his or her own accord, is removed from camp due to an inability to adjust, is unable to function adequately or comply with the rules and regulations of the camp.
- There is no reduction, make-ups or refund based on missed days due to absence, illness or early withdrawal.
- Please note, a service charge of 3% will be applied to all credit card transactions. As many of you know, this has become a standard business practice in New York State when paying with a credit card, as it allows businesses to cover the 3% fee that the credit card company is charging. This charge does not and will not apply to other payment forms such as cash, checks, debit cards, or ACH payments.

Insurance:

All campers are covered by the camp's Accident Insurance Policy for injuries related to camp activities. This does not cover illness. Please note that there is a \$100 deductible for medical reimbursement. The dental insurance coverage is contract limited to \$150. The current cost of liability insurance has made it necessary for us to pass along an insurance fee of \$20 to each camper. The insurance policy serves as a secondary insurance to your child's primary insurance coverage.



Submissions of Camp Dates/Changes:

Any changes made after your initial enrollment request will be honored subject to availability only. All requests must be emailed to sascamp@commonpoint.org for review. If your child was/was not registered for the full summer camp season, any changes made after camp begins will not be eligible for the full season discounted rate.

Campers adding additional weeks once camp begins will be charged \$730 per week for campers entering 1st-3rd grade, \$965 per week for campers entering 4th-6th grade, and \$855 per week for campers entering the G.R.A.D.S. program. Commonpoint reserves the right to cancel any program due to insufficient registration. In the event that a program is canceled, you will be refunded in full without penalty.

Behavior Dismissal:

Commonpoint reserves the right to dismiss any camper from our camp program for UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR: 1. Refusing to follow the behavior guidelines or camp rules. 2. Using profanity, vulgarity, or obscenity 3. Stealing or damaging property 4. Disrupting the program 5. Leaving the program without permission 6. Endangering the health and safety of campers and/or staff. Physical violence towards another camper or staff member will result in immediate dismissal from the camp program. In the event of dismissal, fees will not be refunded and the parent will be responsible for paying the balance for the session fee during which the dismissal takes place.

Photo Release:

Camp registration implies permission to use photos and/or videos taken during camp to be used for both print and electronic media for the Commonpoint's promotion (brochures, posters, internet, ads, etc.)

**Lunch/Snack:**

A Glatt Kosher lunch program is offered for all campers, as well as daily snack. When sending lunch with your camper, please respect the Kosher guidelines of our agency. It is recommended that lunch be packed in insulated lunch bags. All programs include a daily Glatt Kosher snack.

Extended and Early Care:

You must be registered and paid in advance to attend the extended care program. There are limited spots available so please make your selection early.

AM Extended Care is from 7:30AM-9:00AM and PM Extended care is from 4:30PM-6:00 PM. During this time the campers will have snacks, gym activities, movies, computers, playground and other activities.

Trips/Outdoor Park Play:

Registration implies permission for your child to take part in all activities, including trips away from the camp facility. There is no alternative child care for children who choose not to attend a scheduled trip. For trips, yellow school bus transportation will be provided. All campers must have a parent/guardian Off-Site Trip Permission form signed and uploaded on your registration portal.

Medical Information:

All forms must be dated between August 20th, 2026 and September 2027 in order to be valid.

A completed medical form and emergency authorization form must be returned to the camp office or uploaded on to our registration site no later than June 12th 2027. No camper is permitted to begin camp unless we have these forms on file.

Interviews:

A personal interview may be required for new campers. The purpose of this interview is to determine how we can best meet the individual/group needs of your child. Acceptance of campers is contingent upon Camp Director's approval.
